NEW FUND: KIDS COUNT

In the fall of 2019, Jack and Dorene Ross established an endowed fund benefiting Kids Count in Alachua County. This fund was set in place to advance the mission and support the work of Kids Count in Alachua County.

Kids Count was founded in 2007 by a group of citizens concerned about the number of lower income students not graduating in time. The majority of these students stemmed from five elementary schools in the area-- Rawlings, Williams, Duval, Metcalfe, and Lake Forest. To tackle this issue, Kids Count was formed in order to build a highly effective after school program that is sustainable and can be easily duplicated to serve children in these schools. Kids Count provides children in the program with one on one reading tutoring, social-emotional skill development, as well as engaging enrichment opportunities.

This endowed fund is a wonderful opportunity for Kids Count because it will ensure that Kids Count will be strong enough to sustain whatever future financial adversities that may confront them.

DIVERSITY & INCLUSION: A CALL TO ACTION

In September of 2019, the CFNCF hosted "Diversity Inclusion: A Call to Action." Through a series of events, we wanted to not only assess the racial leadership gap in our local nonprofit sector but also implement a method of increasing diversity among local nonprofit boards. On Wednesday, September 11, the Community Foundation and Chamber of Commerce hosted an invitation-only roundtable lunch for local leaders of color facilitated by BoardSource Senior Consultant Vicki Clark. Fifteen leaders attended and held an open and candid conversation about the local climate.



Partnering with Gainesville Black Professionals (GBP), we hosted a special "All Aboard" Board Academy the following day for GBP members interested in serving on nonprofit boards. Surveys were administered among participants. We had 40 people complete the survey, and 22 attended. Following the event, participants were asked what takeaway item they planned to utilize in the future.




Finally, the CFNCF organized a community-wide breakfast session featuring Vicki. This session focused on why diversity and inclusion are important and what nonprofits are doing incorrectly. Eighty-eight people participated in the event . From a survey of 65 people, it was found that the average board size was 7, more than 50% of respondents were actively seeking a new board member, and more than 60% did not currently have a board diversity plan in
