Successful Launch of our Nonprofit Loan Fund

- Established with an investment of \$50,000, the Nonprofit Loan Fund is the first of its kind in our region offering nonprofits access to flexible capital in the form of repayable loans. As loans are repaid, funds become available for use with other projects, creating a continual recycling of charitable capital. These short-term, zero-interest loans are available to nonprofits located in and support the residents of North Central Florida. Priority is given to organizations awarded reimbursable grants. Peaceful Paths was the first recipient of a \$25,000 loan that has since been fully repaid.

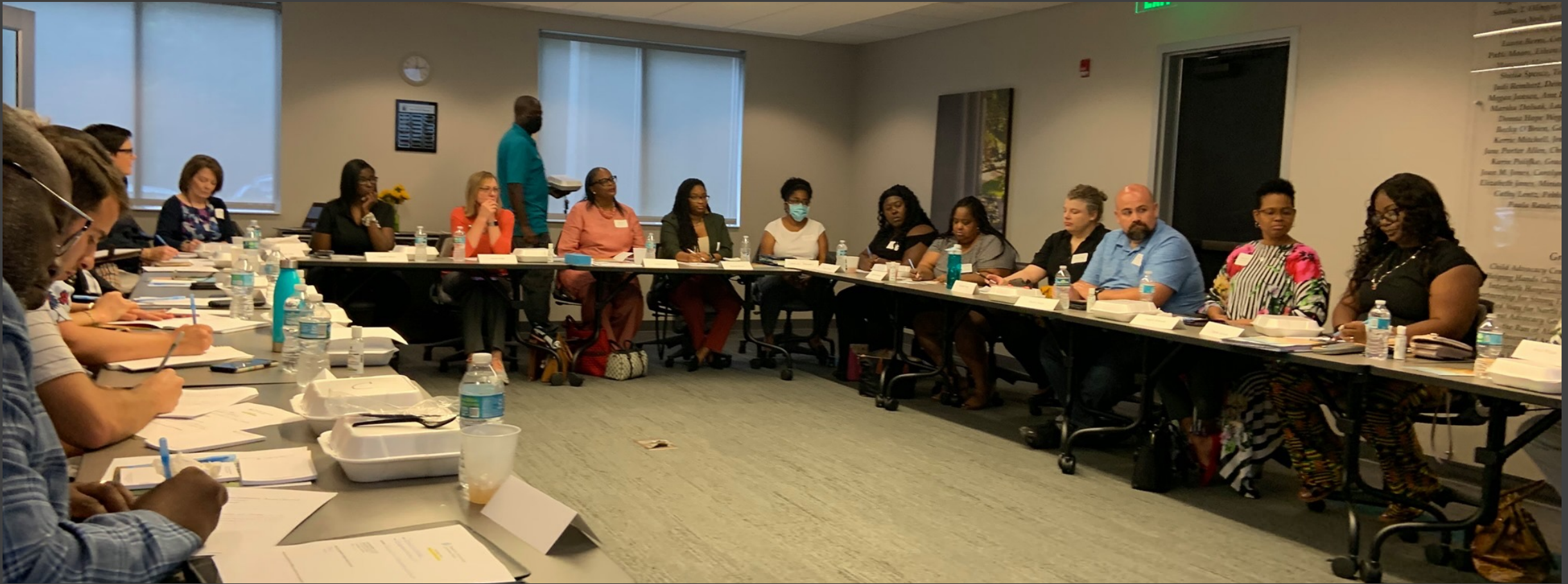

Rural Providers Convening

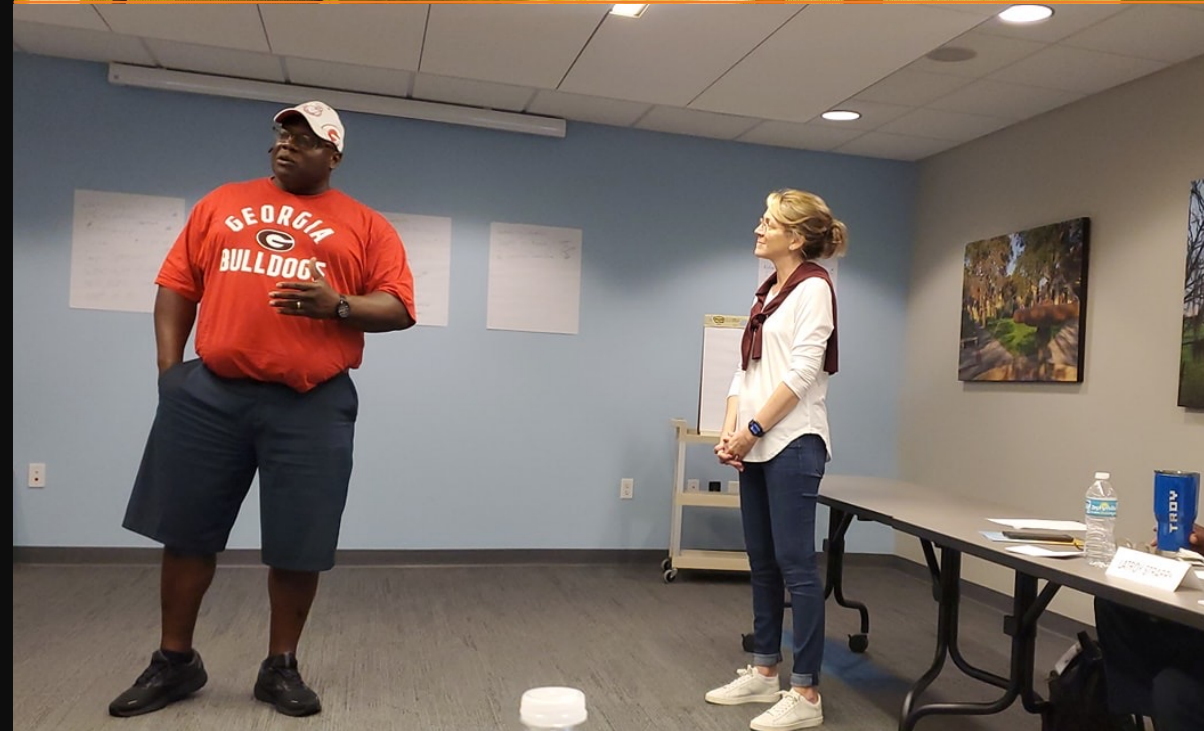
